Dear Library Director:

Thank you for your interest in the Office of Commonwealth Libraries' statewide virtual reference service called Ask Here PA. Opportunities to participate in Ask Here PA are ongoing and I am pleased to provide you with information about becoming a participating library. Ask Here PA adds a new mode of service to patrons, offering them immediate live assistance regardless of their location. By sharing a system and pooling human resources and expertise, Ask Here PA enables libraries to offer a service that most could not provide independently. Ask Here PA utilizes QuestionPoint software from OCLC as the software to use for Ask Here PA. Ask Here PA is available to the residents of Pennsylvania 24 hours per day, 7 days per week.

Please note: you do not have to contribute staff time or submit a partnership agreement in order for your users to have access to the service. All citizens of Pennsylvania will be permitted to use the service regardless of participation by their library. However, we hope you will wish to help support the service through contribution of staff.

The following is required of libraries interested in participating:

1. Submit an Ask Here PA partnership agreement form to the Office of Commonwealth Libraries.
2. Select a Site Coordinator (The Site Coordinator should be a supervisory level staff member within the reference department. This person will serve as the liaison to Ask Here PA staff.)
3. Provide staff to Ask Here PA. The number of hours will be negotiated. The hours are scheduled and the schedule will be negotiated between your Site Coordinator and the Ask Here PA Coordinator.
4. Provide staff for training. Training will occur either at your library or a nearby library.
5. Add links from your website to the Ask Here PA service and promote Ask Here PA to your users.
